1. Minutes circulated and agreed.
2. Matters arising.
 - 2.1 Phone Lines: Simon Helliwell (Eigg) informed Community Council of the Knoydart and Eigg Broadband projects. He conducted a 'walk' of the village with Duncan Gibson and Grahaeme Young looking at suitable host sites. It is a very viable prospect that Glenfinnan can set up a similar project for faster broadband in the village. Next steps: Grahaeme to produce a letter for residents in order to gauge level of interest in the scheme. Alistair Gibson to check out mast on the hill as a possible primary host site.
 - 2.2 Road Issues: Duncan Gibson and Grahaeme Young attended meeting on April 2nd with B. Mitchell and Mark Smith, Capital Road Works Programme. The meeting was very positive. The issue of signage will be addressed and road markings are to be investigated. There was no discussion regarding the possibility of a pavement through the village. Awaiting results of further investigations.
 - 2.3 Village defibrillator and training: Eileen has been in communication with Liah White regarding British Heart Foundation application. Application being processed awaiting outcome.
 - 2.4 Hydro Schemes: Dot Ferguson has written to companies involved and is awaiting their response.
