1. Minutes circulated and agreed
2. Matters arising
  - 2.1. Phone lines: ongoing: Letter received from Dave Thomson MP agreeing to look into the Broadband speed issue.
  - 2.2. Road issues: ongoing. B Mitchell replied to letter and apologised for delayed response. A report is to be published in late November and a meeting is proposed thereafter. The idea of a pavement in the lower village was raised by Duncan Gibson. To be explored further.

  - 2.5. Phone box: – Cnclr. Henderson contacted Arthur Cowie on our behalf about the different levels leading up to phone box. Mr Cowie has recommended that the Disability Access Panel officially contact BT to rectify this.
